# **Registration Fee/Daily Costs:**

A one-time registration fee of \$100.00 will secure a position for your child in the program.

After August 1<sup>st</sup>, the registration fee will be \$50.00


Summer Recreation Program charges will be \$1.25 per 15 minute increment from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (No cap on charges) After 5 p.m. the rate will be \$1.00 per 1 minute increment.


Harvest Christian School Enrolled Students: Families are charged for use on a daily basis and will be sent a bill after the month ends. All bills must be paid within 2 weeks or you will be charged a \$25.00 late fee.

\$300 for 2 or more children enrolled in Summer Rec. As each family uses Summer Rec., money is deducted from their account. If the balance on their account falls lower than the required amount, the family can-

account to meet the required balance.

Payments can be made in the School Office or the Summer Rec. drop box. Any remaining balances at the end of Summer Rec. will be mailed to the family or transferred to their School Account.









## **LUNCH IS NOT PROVIDED:**

Student must bring a lunch with them each day of the program.

#### **Dress Code:**

Our dress code has been established to develop student attitudes and behaviors that honor the Lord Jesus Christ and promote spiritual growth. The summer dress code is the same as the school-year dress code with one exception – open-toed shoes are allowed. No spaghetti straps, tube tops or open back shirts.
