

Harvest Christian School Summer 2022 Recreation Program

Harvest Christian School is once again offering a Summer Recreation Program for families that attend Harvest Christian School or Harvest Christian Fellowship.

Age/Program Requirements:

It is required that at least **one** parent of every student at Harvest Christian School's Summer Recreation Program be a practicing Christian **AND** a participating member of Harvest Christian Fellowship **OR** have a student enrolled in the 2022-2023 school year at Harvest Christian School.

Age Requirements:

Students Entering Grades K through 6

JR. K. EXCEPTION: Students who are enrolled in the 2022—2023 year at Harvest Christian School who have maturity readiness and have the ability to use the restroom independently without assistance are also welcome.

Registration Fee/Daily Costs:

A one-time registration fee of \$100.00 will secure a position for your child in the program.

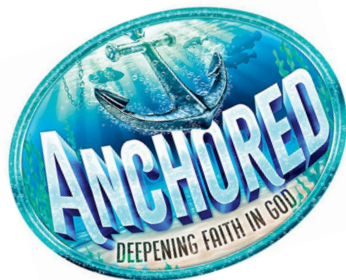
After August 1st, the registration fee will be \$50.00

Summer Recreation Program charges will be \$1.25 per 15 minute increment from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. (No cap on charges)

After 6 p.m. the rate will be \$1.00 per 1 minute increment.

Harvest Christian School Enrolled Students: Families are charged for use on a daily basis and will be sent a bill after the month ends. All bills must be paid within 2 weeks or you will be charged a \$25.00 late fee.

Students Not Enrolled at Harvest Christian School: Families will be required to keep a balance of \$150 for 1 child and \$300 for 2 or more children enrolled in Summer Rec. As each family uses Summer Rec., money is deducted from their account. If the balance on their account falls lower than the required amount, the family cannot use Summer Rec. until they deposit enough money into their account to meet the required balance.

Dress Code:

Our dress code has been established to develop student attitudes and behaviors that honor the Lord Jesus Christ and promote spiritual growth. Program Components Consist of:

* **Bible Every Morning/Devotional Every Afternoon**

Children will participate in a Bible study lesson everyday. Our goal for teaching the Bible is that each child receives Christian Discipleship at their level so that they may learn how to better live out their faith in Jesus Christ.

* **Computer Fun Tuesdays & Thursdays**

We will utilize our computer lab and use Math, Language, and Grammar in fun programs to challenge problem solving and keep up skills.

* **Music Program for 3rd—6th grade once a week**

Music classes for all 3rd - 6th grade students once a week. Lessons will be 30 minutes.

* **P.E. on Mondays & Wednesdays & Friday Fun Days**

The P.E. Assistant, will continue to keep students active with creative and fun exercises for all students. Bowling in the Gym will be on Wednesdays. The P.E. Assistant will also be in charge of Friday Fun Day.
